### Challenge

In June 2018 the City had over 1,634 outstanding late invoices, with a total value of over \$9 million. Late payments are costly to small businesses.

### Performance Goal

Reduce the number of late payments to vendors by 50%.

### Results

MOSS collaborated with finance to improve payment data reporting and worked with agencies to identify obstacles to paying invoices on time. Since June 2018, when MOSS started tracking late payments, the number of late invoices owed by the City has been cut in half.

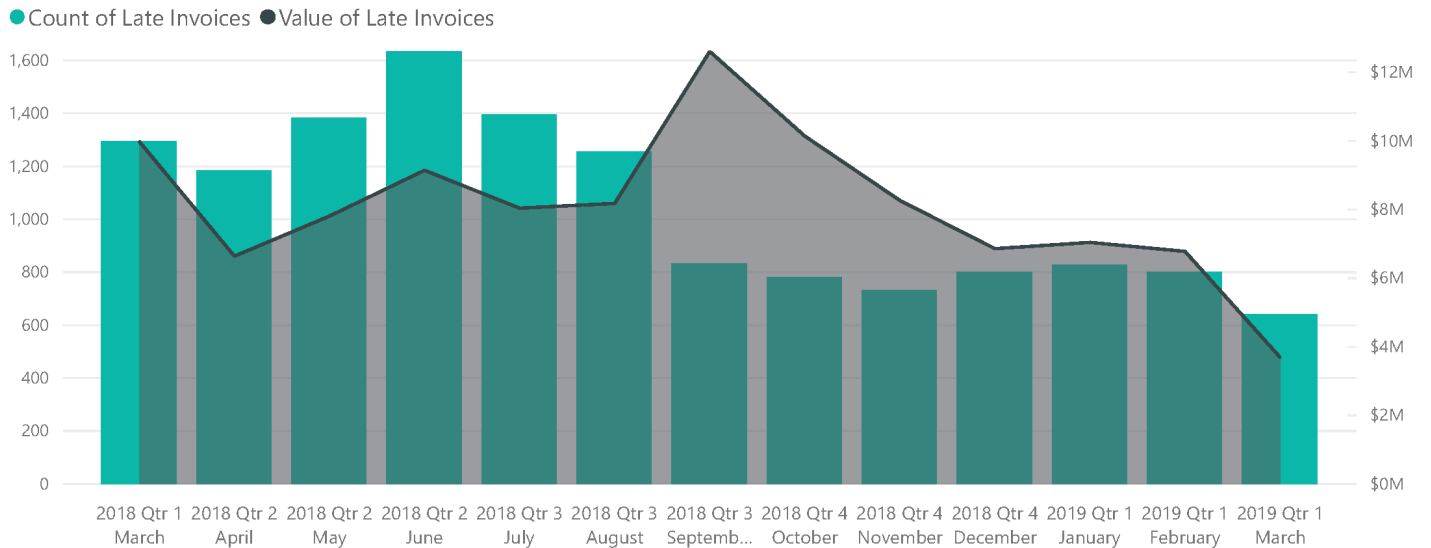
